



# Lead Finder Local Consultants Sites Initial Installation And Configuration

Your new website comes as single zip file that will install and create your new site. The review site is a WordPress based, self hosted installation.

## REQUIREMENTS

To install your review site you will need a domain name and web hosting.

If you do not have either I suggest purchasing a domain name from <http://Godaddy.com> and the “baby” hosting offered by <http://hostgator.com>.

You can install the site on a main domain, a subdomain or a subfolder of a domain. However I strongly recommend buying a domain name specifically for your site.

You may chose any domain name you like but again I recommend you choose one that it related to the niche and reflects the name of your review site.

By default your new site will be called “Find The Best \*\*\*\* Solutions”. You should change that to a name unique to you and one you can find a domain name for.

i.e. “Top Weight Loss Reviews” or “Muscle Building Program Reviews” or “Survivalist Solutions” etc.

## INSTALLING

To install your new site you will need to install a default WordPress installation. Your hosting control panel (cPanel) should have an automated WordPress installer included. It will be found in the “Software and services” section. There are various installers i.e. QuickInstall, Fantastico or Softaculous.

## EXAMPLE



Your particular installer will depend on your specific host.

If your host does not include an automated installer then you should seriously consider changing your host. However as a last resort you can install a clean version of WordPress manually using the instructions at the link below.



## INSTALL PLUGIN

Login to your new WordPress site and go to Plugins/Add New and search for **WP Clone by WP Academy**.


Move or copy a WordPress site to another server or to another domain name, move to/from local server hosting, and backup sites.

Install and Activate that plugin and click the new menu item “WP Clone” in the left hand dashboard menu to see the installation window as shown below.


Use the above button to refresh your backup list. It will list *all* the zip files found in the backup directory, it will also remove references to files that no longer exist.

Check the PHP version is at least 5.4. (as shown in the details above). If not you need to change or update the php version. In many hosting this is in an option in your cPanel but if not check your hosting support knowledge-base for instructions. If you are still stuck you will need to open a support ticket with your hosting provider and ask them to change your PHP version.

As shown below select “Restore From URL” and copy and paste the installation URL from the download page into the big yellow restore field.

Check the I Agree box and hit the big yellow “Restore From URL” button.

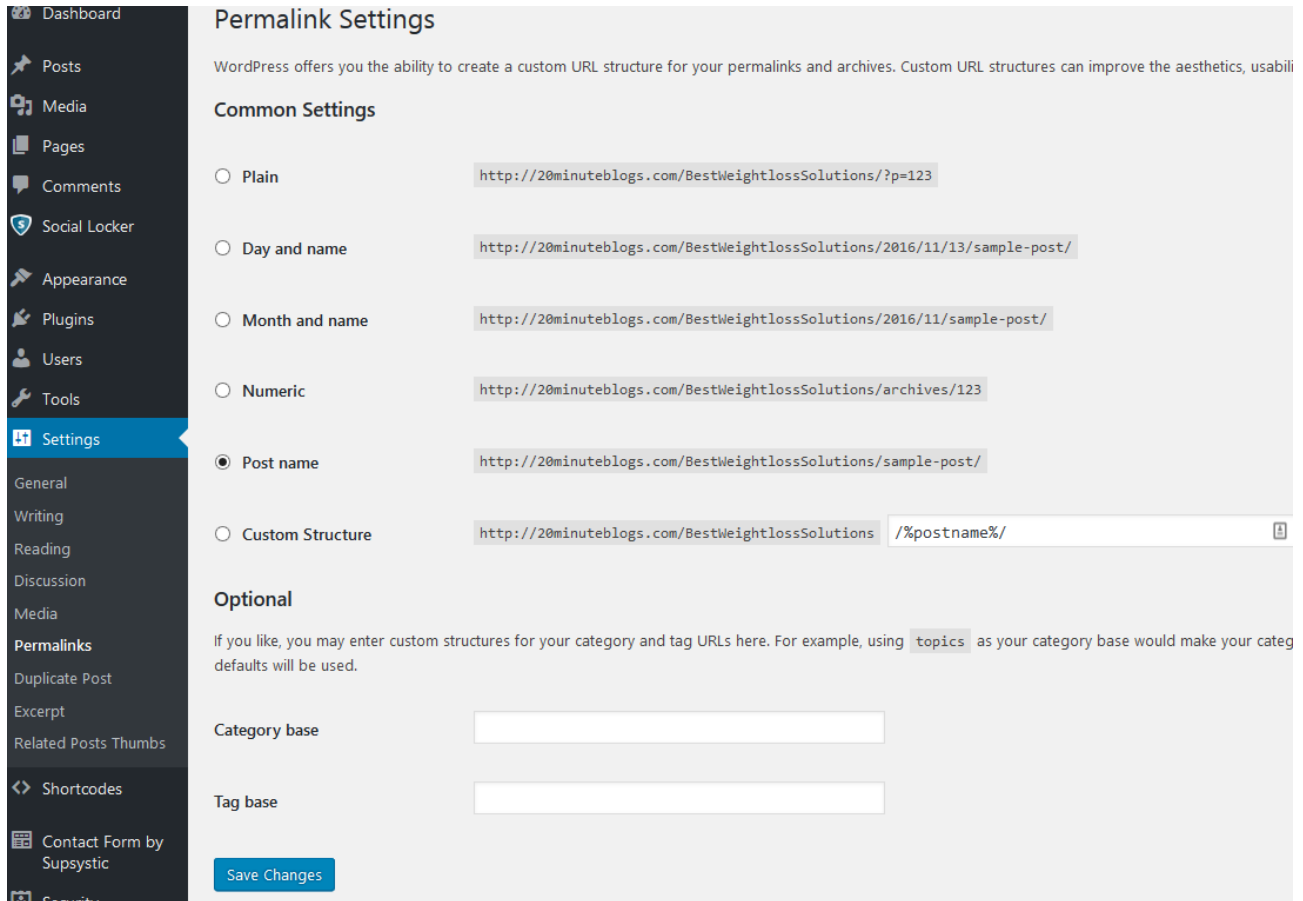
Accept any prompts to install your new site.

When complete you will see a message requesting you to login and Save Your Permalinks.

**Note that you will now have a new username and password. Use the username and password listed on the download page to access your new website.**

Copy and paste the login details ensuring no leading or lagging spaces or unwanted characters.

Go to Settings/Permalinks in the dashboard menu and click “Save”. The settings should look like the screenshot below



## YOUR SITE IS INSTALLED

Your new site should now be installed.


## IMPORTANT SECURITY MEASURE

The next step is to change your password. The current password is generic and will be known by all blog owners so you need to immediately change it for security.

Go to Users/Your Profile and update your profile with your own details i.e. name and email address.

Generate a new password and Update Profile.

Ensure you have copied your password to a safe place before saving.




Logo out and log back in with your new password to ensure all is working OK

## CHANGE SITE NAME & ADMIN EMAIL

### **IMPORTANT. THERE ARE FOUR DIFFERENT ADMIN EMAILS YOU NEED TO CHANGE**

1. From Settings/General change the site name to suit your new domain and change the Admin Email to your own.





It is important to check and change all the email addresses within your new site. If you do not then you will not receive your admin messages and customer contact form etc. Check and change the following:

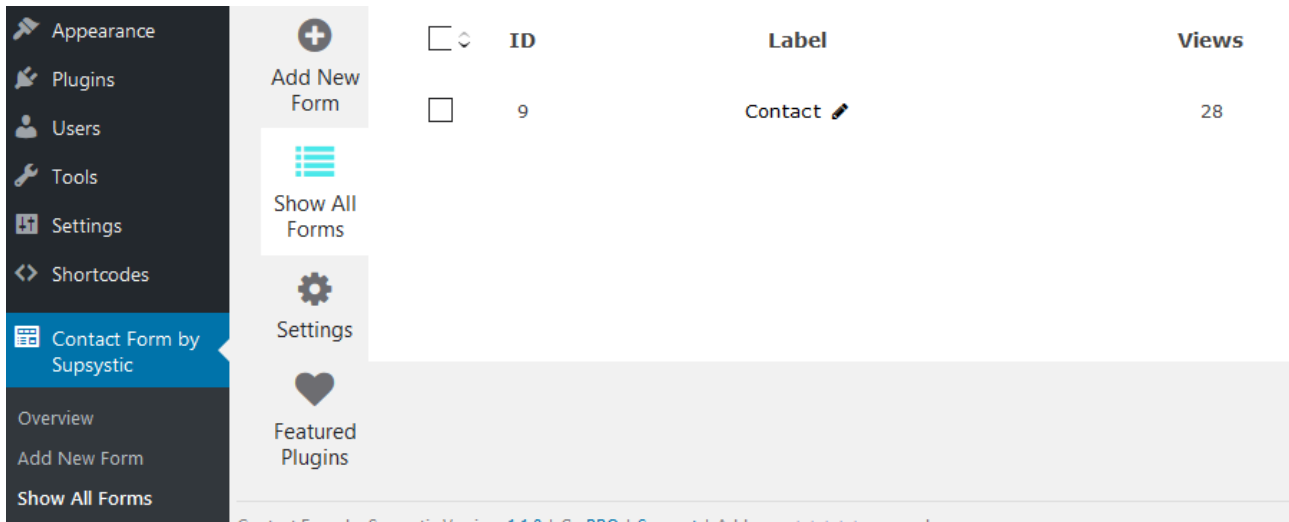
2. From Users/Your Profile change the email address and add your correct name etc.



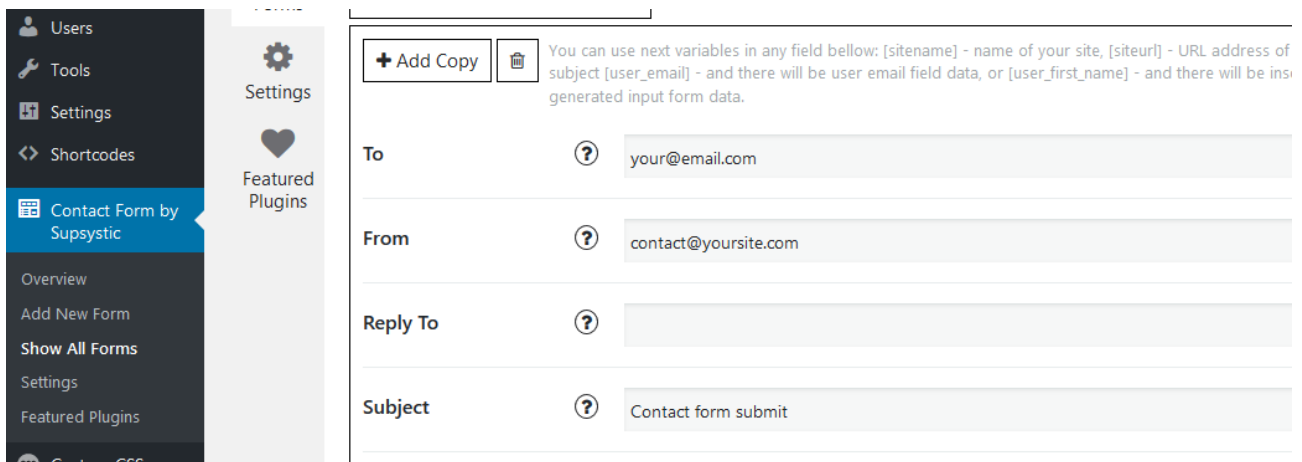

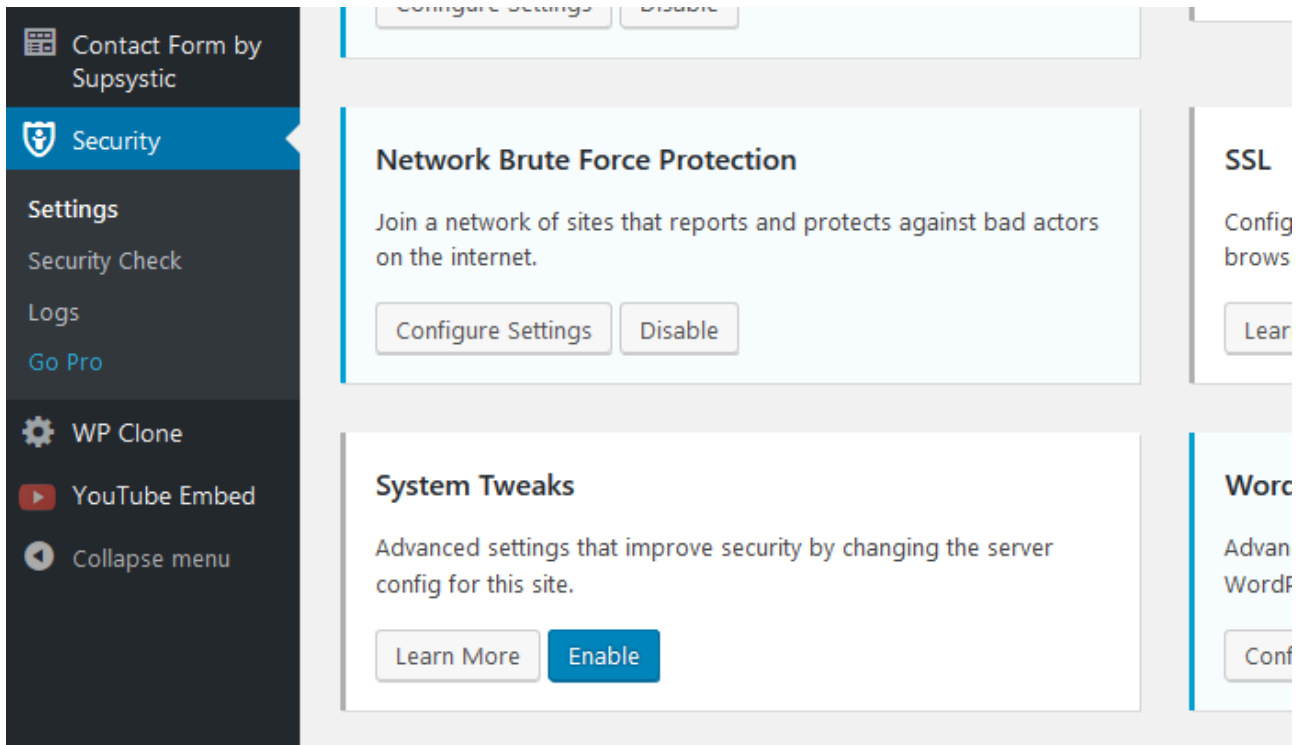
## ITHEMES SECURITY AND EMAIL ADDRESS

It is important to ensure your site is protected against cyber attack and you are kept updated with any security issues.

**Activate the iThemes Security plugin.**

4. From SECURITY/SETTINGS





In “Network Brute Force Protection” Click the “Configure Settings” Button.

Click the Reset API and ensure your email address is displayed.

#### Network vs Local Brute Force Protection

Local brute force protection looks only at attempts to access your site and bans users per the lockout rules specified locally. Network brute force protection takes this a step further by banning users who have tried to break into other sites from breaking into yours. The network protection will automatically report the IP addresses of failed login attempts to iThemes and will block them for a length of time necessary to protect your site based on the number of other sites that have seen a similar attack.

To get started with iThemes Network Brute Force Protection, please supply your email address and save the settings. This will provide this site with an API key and starts the site protection.

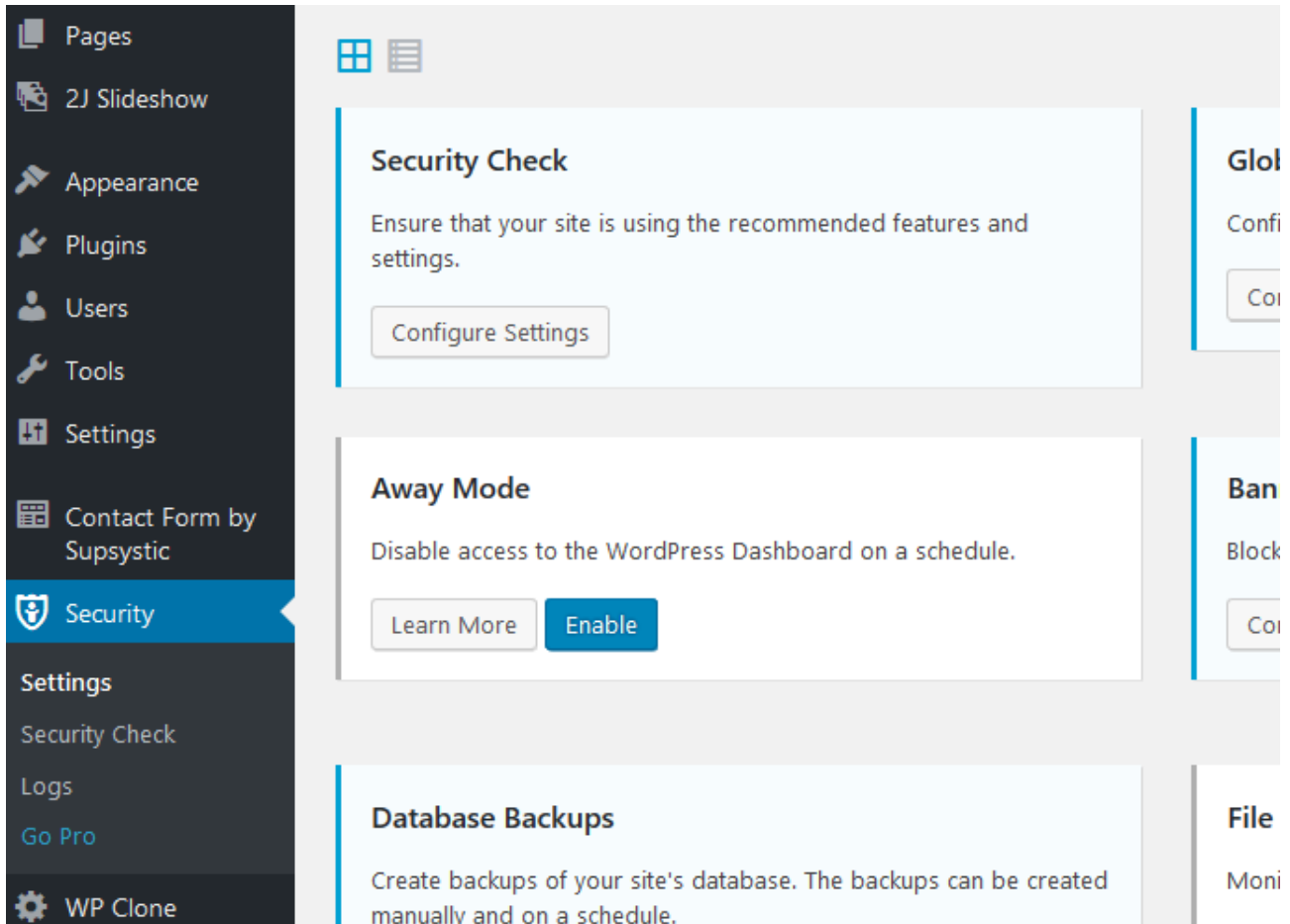
